IDENTITY & COLOUR BREAKDOWN

The Wheelchair Rugby Canada identity consists of a corporate mark that comes in 4 variations. Care must be taken to ensure that these marks are used in their entirety as displayed and that accurate colour reproduction is maintained when reproduced in print, web and broadcast applications.

CREST VARIATIONS & FILE TYPES

The Wheelchair Rugby Canada mark is available in a crest configuration. There are colour, contained colour, reverse, black and grayscale versions of each configuration. See below for best use practices.



Colour Crest

The Colour Crest should appear on a white/ lightly coloured background. Overly patterned backgrounds should be avoided.

Contained Crest

The Contained Colour Crest should be used when a colour logo is meant to appear on a detailed background.

Reversed Crest

The White Crest should be used when the logo is being set on a solid or less detailed background as an alternative to the Contained Crest.

Black Crest

The Black Crest should be used on internal documents that are likely to be photocopied/scanned and are therefore more susceptible to generation loss.

Contained Bilingual Crest

The Contained Bilingual Crest should be used when a colour logo is meant to appear on a detailed background.

Reversed Bilingual Crest

The Reversed Bilingual Crest should be used when the logo is being set on a solid or less detailed background as an alternative to the Contained Crest.

Black Bilingual Crest




HORIZONTAL ENGLISH VARIATION


HORIZONTAL FRENCH VARIATION

The Wheelchair Rugby Canada mark is available in a Horizontal French configuration. There are colour, contained colour, reverse, black and grayscale versions of each configuration. See below for best use practices.



PROTECTIVE SPACE

The Wheelchair Rugby Canada identity, and all its variations, must clearly stand out wherever it appears. One way to ensure this is by maintaining clear space around the identity. Protective space is an area that is kept free of any other text, graphic elements or other visual distractions.



MINIMUM SIZE

The Wheelchair Rugby Canada identity, and all its variations, should never be smaller then the outlined minimum size to remain legible.

MINIMUM SIZE

Identity should not appear smaller than 1.5" wide or it could become illegible. Identity width is measured from the left edge to the right edge of the Wheelchair Rugby Canada logo.

INCORRECT IDENTITY USAGE

The Wheelchair Rugby Canada identity, and all it's variations, have been created to work across a broad range of applications. The identity (in both its crest and horizontal forms) should not be modified or be recreated in any way. This page illustrates some, but not all, of the possible misuses.

23 PATTERNED BACKGROUNDS

Never place on a overly patterned background.

CONTRACTION

Never modify the identity by stretching, flipping or rotating any part of the identity or as a whole.

O PROTECTIVE SPACE

Be sure to leave appropriate protective space around the identity.











APPROVED TYPEFACES & USAGE

The typeface of the Wheelchair Rugby Canada identity is DIN. This font family is both bold and unique yet easy to read. This font family offers a variety of weights for various applications.

HEADLINES & SUBHEADS

Use Trade Gothic Lt Std Bold Condensed No. 20 for all headlines.

Subheads should appear smaller using Trade Gothic Lt Std Bold Condensed No. 20.

TRADE GOTHIC LT STD -Bold Condensed No. 20

BODY & LEGAL COPY

Use Trade Gothic Lt Std Regular for all body copy. Sentence case with regular tracking is recommended.

Trade Gothic Lt Std Bold No. 2 may be used in body copy to highlight a word or short phrase OR be used as body copy on dark backgrounds.

Trade Gothic Lt Std Regular may also be used for legal copy where legibility at a small font size is required.

CAPTIONS & CALL-OUTS

Use Trade Gothic Lt Std - Bold No. 2 for all captions and call-outs. Sentence case with regular tracking is recommended.
