These services can be investigated with the Canadian Sport Centre in your region. Training Environment also includes Club Recruitment Activities such as, but not exclusively, BTG sessions.

Funding will be based on completing 4 out of 5 of the following criteria;

### **BRONZE (\$500.00) – Options:**

- Practise a minimum of once per month to once per week, as a club
- Participate in at least one Recruitment Activity
- Organize and implement at least one IST session
- Submit 20-meter sprint tests in November and February
- Coach contributes to Prospect Camp Selections

### **SILVER (\$1,000.00) – Options:**

- Practise a minimum of twice a week as a club
- Participate in at least two Recruitment Activities
- Organize and implement at least two IST session
- Submit 20-meter sprint tests in November and February
- Coach contributes to Prospect Camp Selections

### **GOLD (\$1,500.00) – Options:**

- Practise a minimum of twice a week as a club
- Participate in three, or more, Recruitment Activities
- Organize and implement three, or more, IST session
- Submit 20-meter sprint tests in November and February
- Coach contributes to Prospect Camp Selections

**NOTE:** Funds will be provided for expenses necessary to deliver the program. Detailed receipts for gym rental and/or IST fees must be submitted.

This year we have put aside some funding for Canadian wheelchair rugby clubs to acquire new athlete-specific chairs for their developing athletes who have shown solid potential. Wheelchair Rugby Canada would agree to subsidize up to 50% of the cost of the chair up to a maximum of \$4,000 CAD per chair. Wheelchair Rugby Canada will subsidize up to a maximum of 2 chairs per club. The club would have to prove that they have the remaining funds or funding in place to secure the balance of the cost of the chair. The club would also have to justify the need of the new chair, with some additional rationale and information on the intended recipient.
